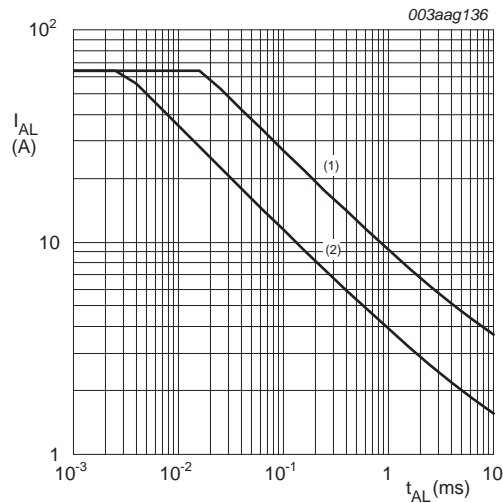

Fig 1. Continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature



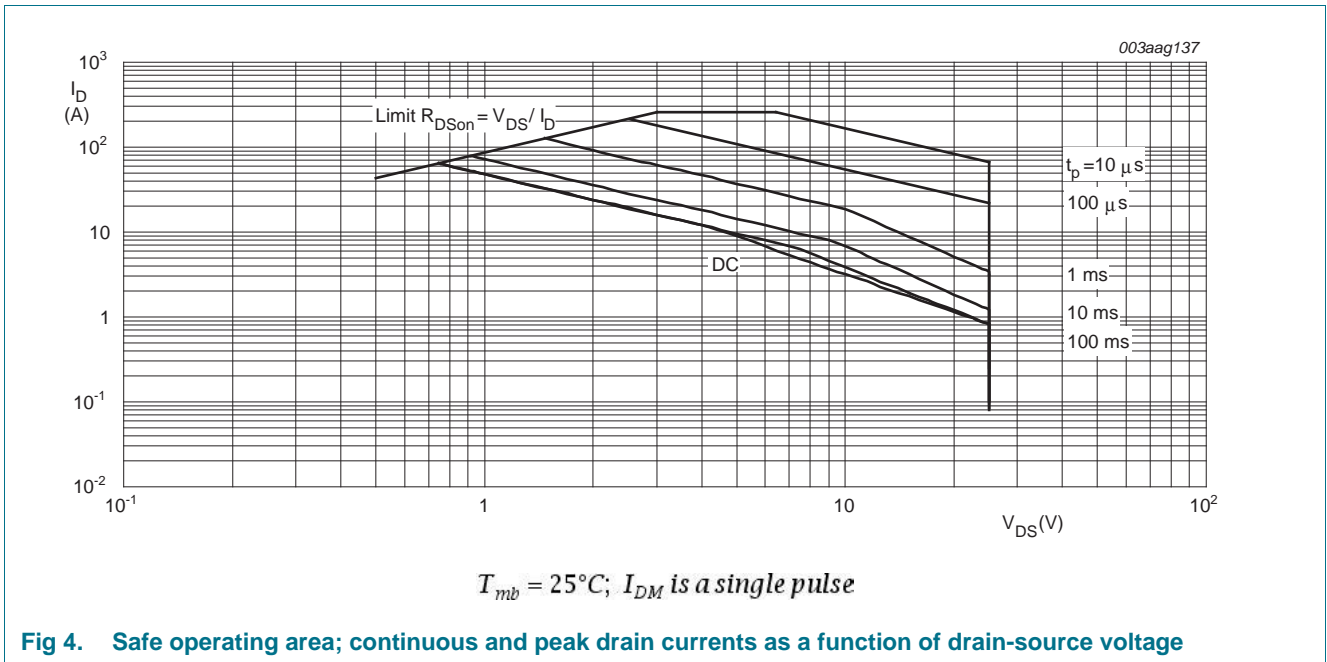

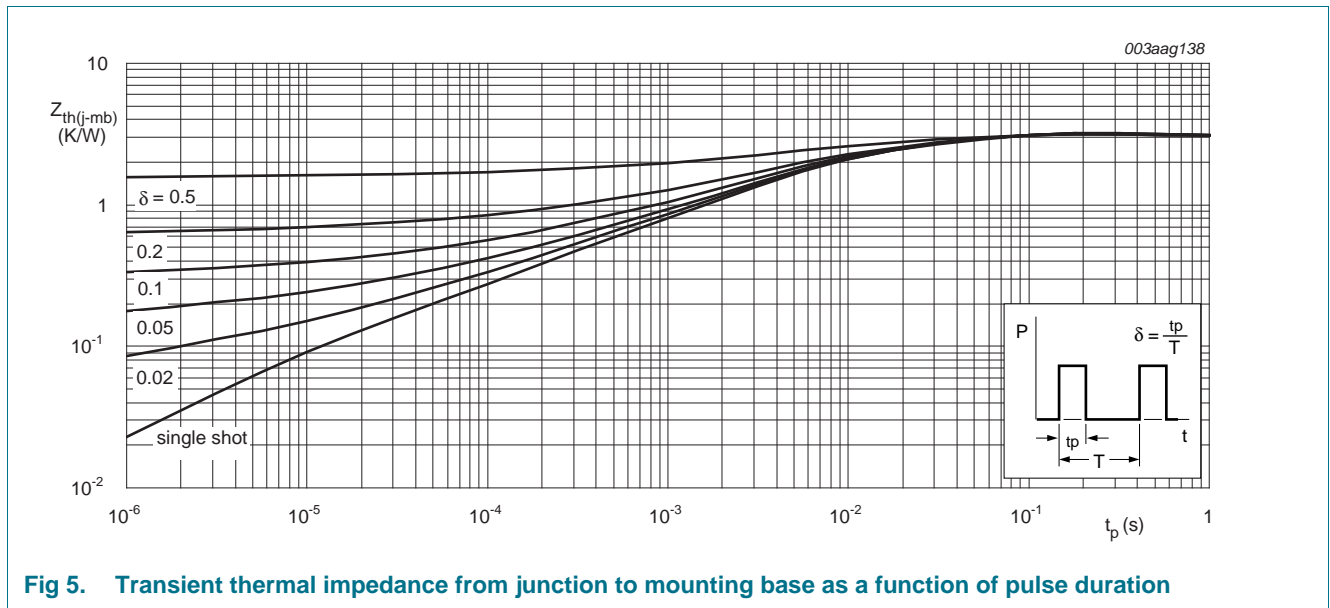


Fig 5. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration

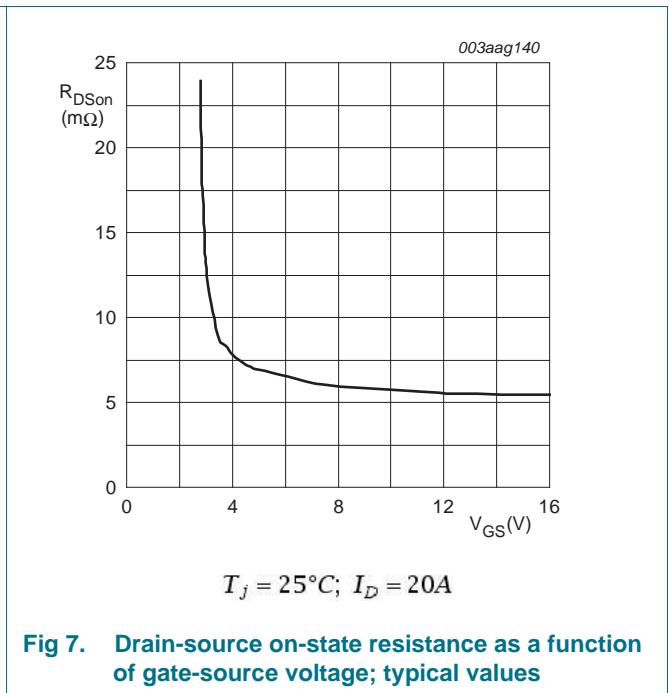
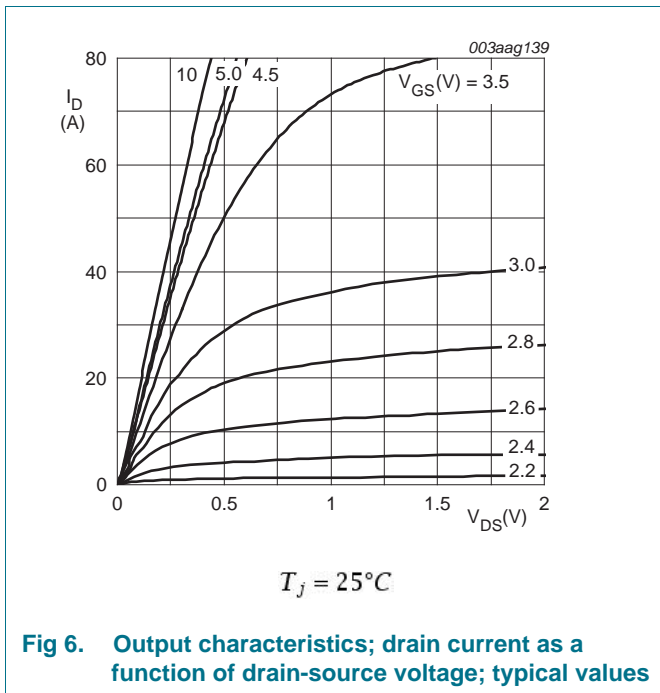

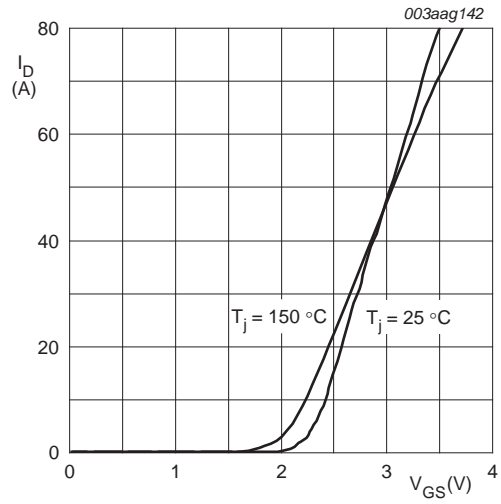

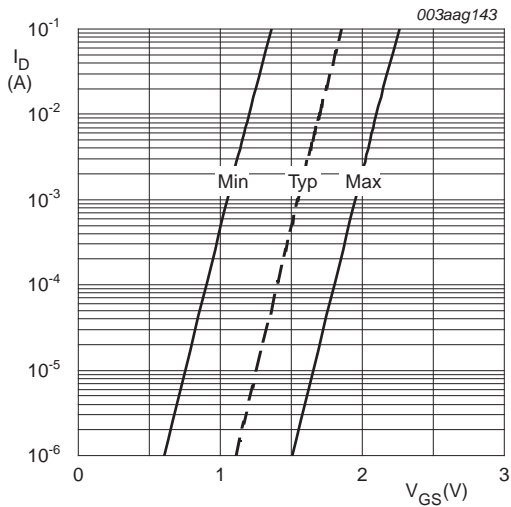

Fig 8. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values



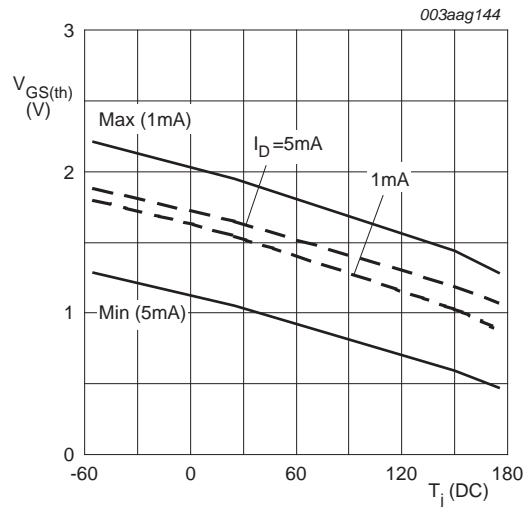

Fig 9. Transfer characteristics; drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values



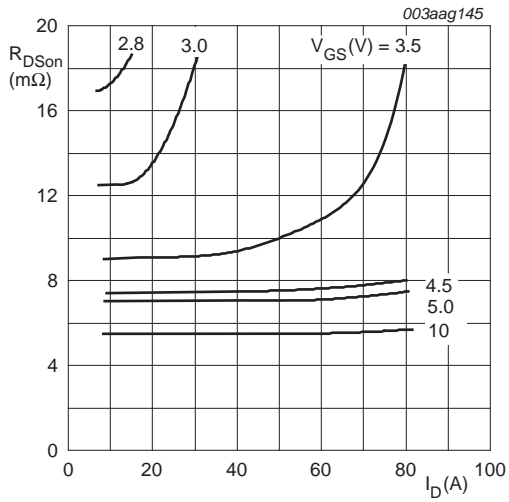

Fig 10. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage



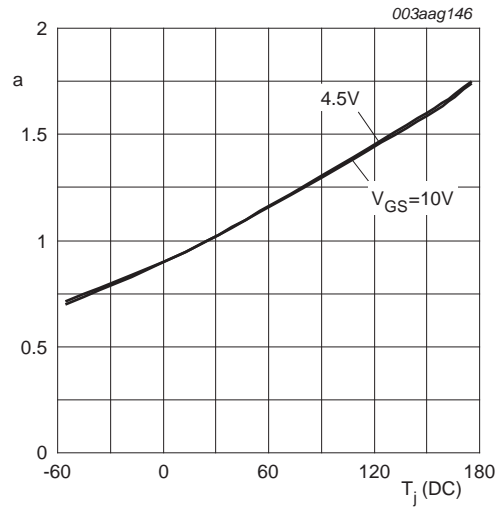

Fig 13. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature

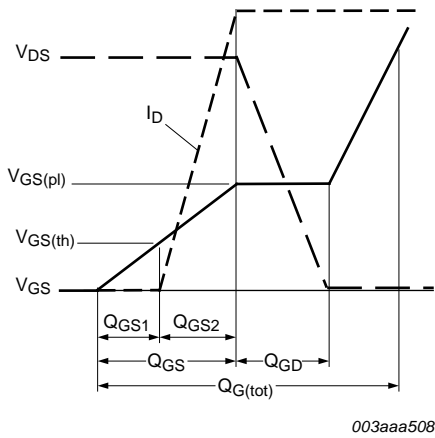
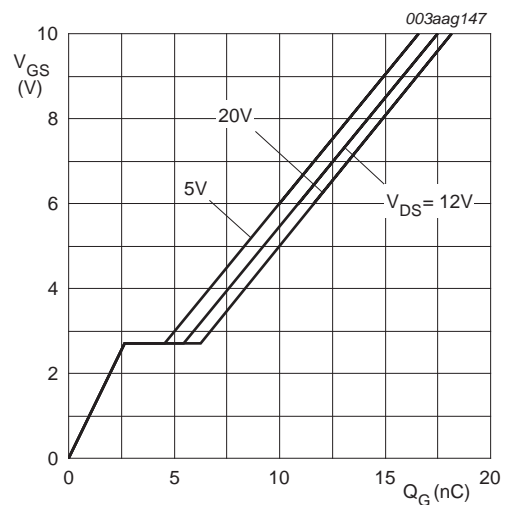
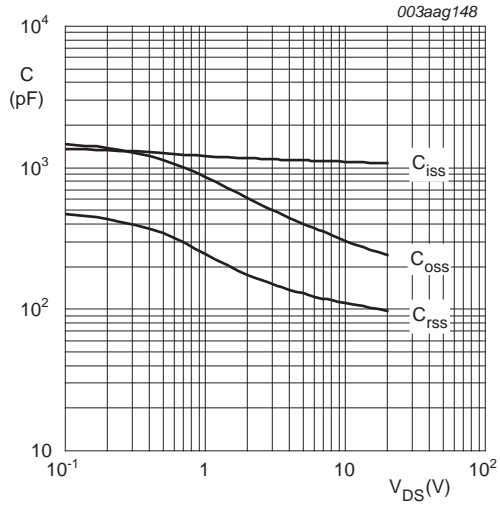


Fig 14. Gate charge waveform definitions



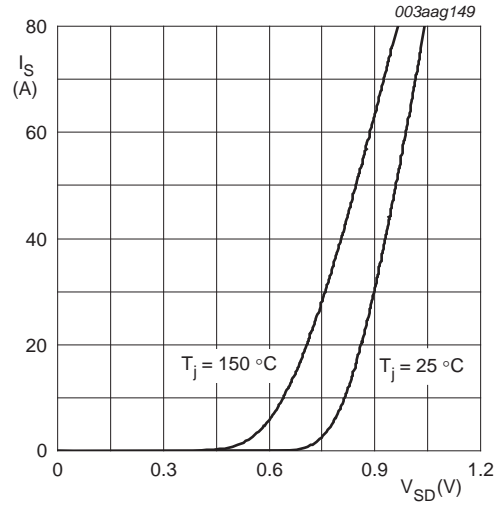

Fig 17. Source current as a function of source-drain voltage; typical values

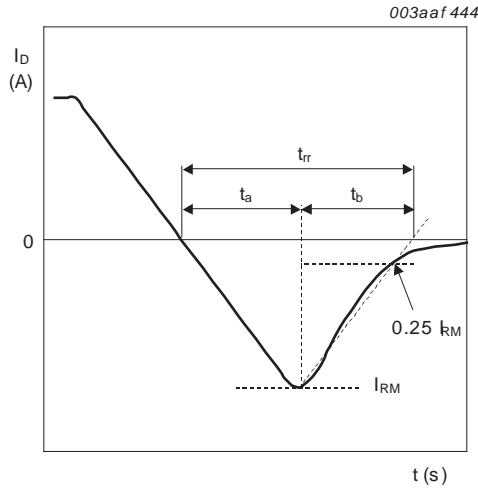


Fig 18. Reverse recovery timing definition

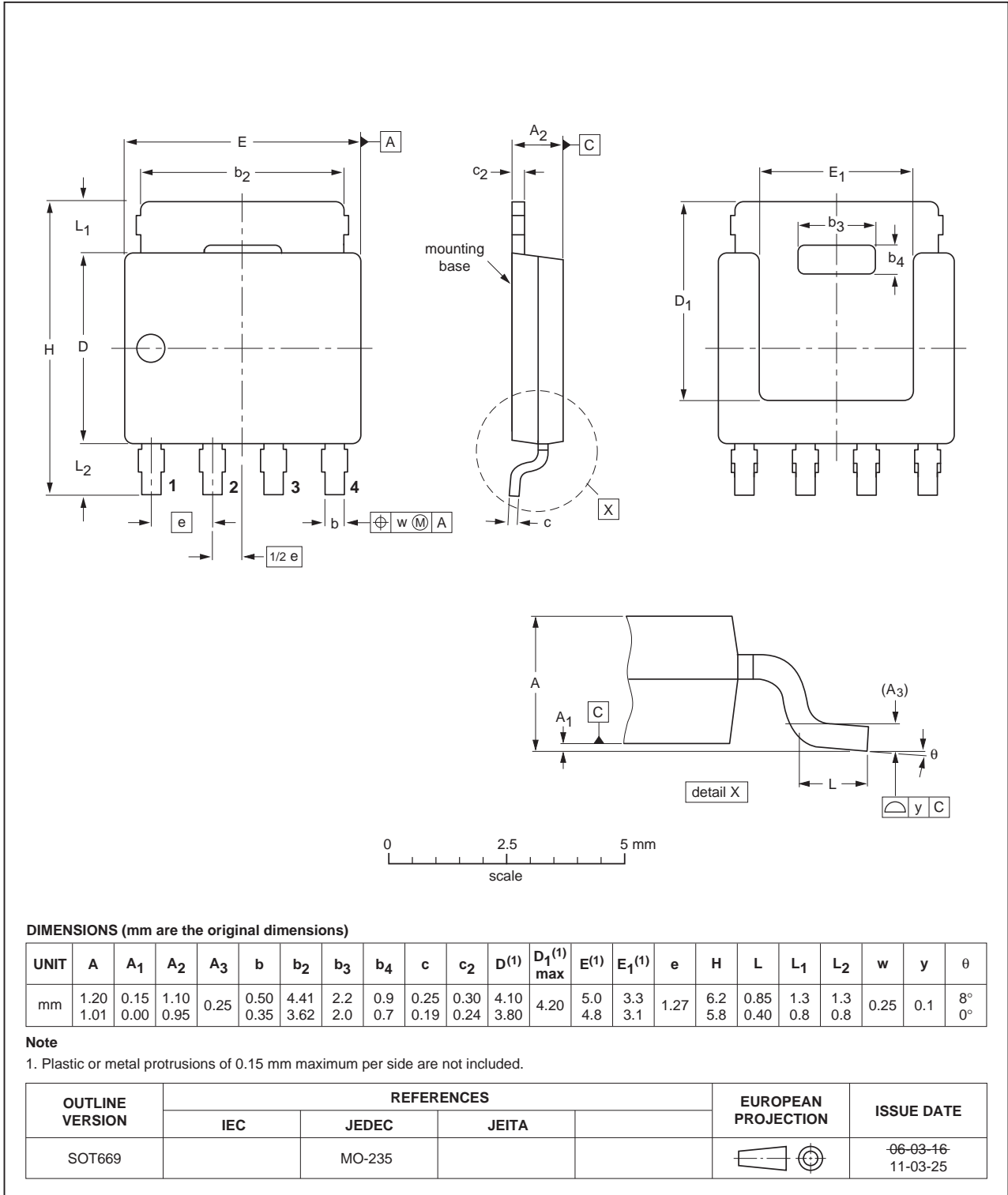


Fig 19. Package outline SOT669 (LPAK; Power-SO8)
